**Call to Order:** President Wilkerson called the meeting to order at 10:08 a.m.

### Treasurer's Finance Report, Samantha Huggins

Treasurer Huggins has reached out to institutions that didn't pay their dues last year, have only received a check from one.

Membership dues, Registrar's Therapy and Boot Camp registration fees are coming in.

Filed extension on taxes. We received a check from the IRS for overpayment for 2018, but then a bill for not paying taxes in 2017.

Going to get bids on an accountant and have an electronic vote to approve hiring an accountant.

VP Calhoun moved to approve the treasurers report second by VP Sims. Motion passed and treasurer's report approved.



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#### President, Zeda Wilkerson

President Wilkerson is working on filling sessions for fall conference and producing the agenda. We need 18 sessions. Not including keynote or closing.

Decided against doing a pre-conference workshop due to the travel time.

The cost of the conference is expensive, and we might should consider not doing the T-shirts.

Received a quote from Andy Masters as the keynote speaker of \$3,500 plus travel costs (\$500-750), which is consistent pricing with other keynote speakers looked at.

Really need to get registration completed for the food to be ordered by September 21.<sup>st</sup> As long as we have 150+ registrants we should meet our \$4,000 food and beverage minimum. Looking at having Naaman's BBQ cater for the business meeting lunch.

Registration link and hotel room reservation link should go out soon. We have 91 rooms in our room block including 11 rooms for the EC at \$89.

President Wilkerson is going back to Texarkana on August 2 to work out the room set ups hospitality suite details with Ms. Siefert.

President-Elect, Tyler Bittle: No report.

#### Past President, Chad Cox

Created sponsorship registration form for venders for fall conference. Vender/sponsor information is on the website. We have a goal of 8 venders.

Half of the EC will be rolling off, so will be working on slate of officers for the nominations and elections.
